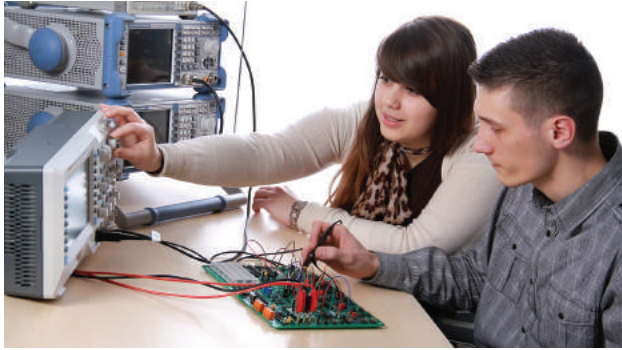
UNIVERSITY OF MARIBOR

SLOVENIA

Slovenia is located in the heart of Europe at the crossroads of the main European cultural and trade routes. It covers 20,273 km² and has a population of 2.06 million. There are many natural attractions all over the country. The country is one of the most water-rich in Europe, while over half of the territory (56%) is covered by forest, which places Slovenia among the three most wooded countries in Europe. It is a parliamentary republic and a member of the United Nations, European Union, and NATO. The capital and largest city is Ljubljana, the second biggest city is Maribor, where UM FERl is located.



MARIBOR

Maribor is the second largest city in Slovenia, nestled along the river Drava in the embrace of the green forests of Pohorje and picturesque wine-growing hills. Maribor prides itself on a profound history and long wine tradition, which is particularly marked by the Old Vine, the oldest vine in the world, which has been growing here for more than 400 years. The city is also known as a university and metropolitan city, and the economic, financial, administrative, educational, cultural, culinarian, commercial and tourist centre of the north-eastern part of Slovenia.

SUBSIDIZED STUDENTS MEALS (Students' coupons):

Slovenia is the only country in Europe with the food coupons system. This means that you can eat a nice student meal in certain restaurants in Maribor or everywhere in Slovenia for three euros on average. The Slovenian Government subsidizes the rest of the meal's price.

THE UNIVERSITY LIBRARY:

The rich library holdings include more than 940,000 units of books and other library materials, as well as more than 3,000 electronic information sources. They offer more than 320 reading places, a computer room, as well as special single-study rooms and rooms for group work. The Library's services are free for all students at the University of Maribor.

STUDENT DORMITORIES:

In Maribor, there are Student dormitories, which are organised in three campuses: Gosposvetska, Tyrševa and Quadro. All campuses are located near the centre and offer plenty of opportunities for sport and recreation. The beds in dormitories are limited!

Slovenia is ranked as one of the most peaceful, safe, politically stable and culturally diverse countries. We have a high standard of living, clean air, a healthy lifestyle and good accommodation. Studying in Slovenia offers you a unique opportunity to discover the country and its neighbours, the culture, cuisine, Slovenian festivals, nature, language, and gain new knowledge.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

All important institutions in Maribor are within a walking distance. In addition we have a well thought through network (more than 20 bus lines) and frequencies of every 10 to 20 minutes during weekdays, the buses are perfect for getting around Maribor. Students have discount on monthly tickets.

STUDENT WORK:

In Slovenia, students can work through an instrument called Student Work. This allows temporary and part-time work for college and university students. They can work via a special type of contract called referral forms/referrals. Employment agencies specialised for student work offer lists of available student jobs and take care of payments.
